

As always, North High has the best commencement. Senior information continues to be emailed to seniors and parents on a regular basis and is also posted on the North High School Guidance Web page.

Graduates will receive caps and gowns on Monday May 17th at 9am, during the ERIC Awards held in the North High Auditorium. With the graduation ceremony being held Thursday May 20th, this should provide ample time to take photos of the graduate in their commencement attire. Photos will not be allowed after the ceremony as graduates will return their gown to receive their high school diploma.

Graduates should enter using the 19th Street, Media Entrance. Only students wearing Cap and Gown will be allowed entry at that point. Parents, family members and friends may enter using the main, Capitol Street Entrance. Prior to the ceremony only graduates will be allowed in the staging area (Civic Auditorium Basement). Parents, family members and friends will not be allowed in this area before or after the ceremony. Please take photos before this time. Only graduate and limited handicapped (the individual + 1) seating will be available on the main floor of the auditorium. All other spectators will be directed to the third and fourth floors for general seating. The Civic auditorium is a large facility, please arrange a meeting point with your student for after commencement. At the conclusion of the ceremony the audience will be directed to exit via Capitol Street. (Civic Auditorium Policy)

REGISTRATION 2010-2011

Current North students have been registered for the 2010-11 school year. Each student should have received a listing of the courses they have requested with their third quarter progress. Errors in input may have occurred or a student OR parent may wish to make a change. Please contact the student's counselor to request a change in the courses selected or to correct an error BEFORE May 21. Schedules will be mailed in early August to each student.

Schedule changes will be limited to the following reasons:

- 1. The course was completed in summer school.
- 2. The student must repeat a course that was failed.
- 3. A scheduling conflict by the school must be resolved.
- 4. Student needs an additional course to meet credit requirements.

Graduation requirements for the Class of 2011 are:

- 8 English credits
- 7 Social Studies credits
- 6 Math credits
- 6 Science credits (Biology, Chemistry, Physics)
- 4 Physical Education credits
- 1 Human Growth & Development credit or Opt Out

Advanced Drama Outreach Plays 2010

Omaha North High drama students are using their theatrical talents this April to educate elementary students about important social issues. Ms. Jordan's Advanced Drama students wrote two plays to be presented: "Stranger Danger" and "Bully Awareness". "Stranger Danger" takes younger elementary students through a series of situations where they may come in contact with strangers, and how to deal with those situations. The play includes a quirky dance and theme song: "Talking to strangers will put you in danger!!" Senior, Alexandria Anderson, directed and wrote a good bit of the "stranger" program. The second play, "Bully Awareness" is directed by senior, **Richard Corum**, and defines bullying, how to deal with it, and why some students are bullies. Older elementary students will learn about the different kinds of bullying including, physical, verbal, and cyber bullying. These programs allow drama students to experience the whole process of theater from initial brainstorming, writing, auditioning, rehearsing, and finally performing.
